1. Co-chairs (2 positions available)

- Oversee the organization and strive for continued success + growth
- Interface with faculty advisors and community partners
- Coordinate meetings with leadership team and assign tasks/projects
- Complete SLAC paperwork etc. to stay up to date with institutional approval
- Spearhead fundraising efforts and obtain grant/student group funding

2. Director of Communication (1 position)

- Website management + updates (<http://acavengers.weebly.com>)
- E-mail listserv maintenance (eg. adding new subscribers after events)
- Creating flyers and promoting events via Wejoinin, Facebook, Email.
- Create or find high quality handouts, presentations, etc. with Director of Education
- Blog posts and social media presence to share success stories

3. Director of Outreach (1 position)

- Coordinate with WithinReach, SHIFA, and UDSM Volunteer Management staff
- Track work and scheduling of all volunteers
- Recruit volunteers from UW student body
- Solicit volunteer feedback and stories in an organized and regular fashion
- Meet with volunteers and organize happy hours, check-ins, etc. as needed

4. Director of Education (1 position)

- Plans bi-monthly meeting topics to help students learn about the ACA
- Communicates with speakers to facilitate scheduling and content
- Reserve rooms and coordinate food + other logistics etc
- Gather feedback from session attendees and use to shape future sessions

5. Director of Advocacy (WWAMI medical students eligible! 1-2 positions)

- Maintain contact with HEC and SLAC
- Attend Sound Alliance trainings and other events as appropriate
- Work on expanding health equity and policy related research projects w/ Kelsen
- Advocating for increased ACA and social impact curriculum at UWSOM and beyond
- Working with Communications Director to put together sound bites and quotes that could be used for lobbying, writing letters to representatives, etc.
